It is to inform that the online link for registration of branch preferences for PUC-II (currently pursuing and students who didn't get promoted to E1 during the last year) students for allocation of branches in E1 for the AY-2020-21, will be kept open from 14.10.2020 by 05:00PM to 28.10.2020 by 11:59 PM.

The students who could not complete their registration in time, such students can submit the request letter manually by paying a late fee of Rs. 500/- with mentioning order of preferences to the Academic Section from 29.10.2020 to 05.11.2020. The students who wish to alter the already given preferences, such students can submit a request letter manually to the Academic Section mentioning their order of preferences by paying a fine of Rs. 500/- for the same from 29.10.2020 to 05.11.2020.

No requests will be considered under any circumstances after 05.11.2020.

The students should go through the manual of instructions before giving their branch preferences.

Manual of Instructions for Branch Allocation 2020-21



Dear students,

1. As a part of 6-year integrated B.Tech programme, branches of engineering will be allocated for only those who passed in the 2-Years PUC with a minimum CGPA ≥ 6 and as per rule of reservation of Govt. of Telangana State.

2. The allocation of engineering branch shall be made on the choice of the students and by resolving based on their performance in the PUC as per the following procedure:

- i. Choice of the students in order of preference going up to all 7 choices due collected on-line.
- ii. Student should have the minimum CGPA of ≥ 6 and puts the students in order of merit as per CGPA up to Sem2-PUC2, in each of the reserved categories and allocate the seats as per the merit order considering the number of seats available in each of the branches for each of the categories of reservation.

3. In case of tie on account of same CGPA, the tie is resolved to decide the relative ranking based on the following criterion:

- a. Average grade in Mathematics courses of first four semesters of PUC.
- b. Next, average grade in Physics courses of first four semesters of PUC.
- c. If the tie still persists, candidate older (based on date of birth) is given preference over the younger.

4. The below are the particulars of branches available in Engineering for the AY2019-20. The number of seats available in Engineering branches will be decided as per Academic rules & regulations in force and by considering the total number of students passing the PUC with a minimum CGPA of ≥ 6 (after taking the remedial examination after 2nd Semester of 2nd Year PUC into consideration) and going by the following ratio (for example if total of 1000 students eligible for branch allocation):

1. Chemical Engineering	71/1000 @ 7.1 per 100 seats
2. Civil Engineering	143/1000 @ 14.3 per 100 seats
3. Computer Science and Engineering	214/1000 @ 21.4 per 100 seats
4. Electrical and Electronics Engineering	144/1000 @ 14.4 per 100 seats
5. Electronics and Communication Engineering	214/1000 @ 21.4 per 100 seats
6. Mechanical Engineering	143/1000 @ 14.3 per 100 seats
7. Metallurgical and Materials Engineering	71/1000 @ 7.1 per 100 seats

5. The rule of reservation for special categories for each branch is as mentioned below as per rules which subject to any changes and amendments made by the Government of Telangana state.

Allocation will be done under special category vacancy only if valid documents (in pdf format with clear visible resolution) are uploaded at **special category tab** while giving branch preferences.

Physically Handicapped (PH) – 3%

CAP – 2%

NCC – 1%

Sports – 0.5% (as per G.O. Ms no 2 - Sports dated 22.09.2020)

Eligibility criteria and Certificates to be uploaded by PH / CAP / NCC / Sports Candidates (multiple pages can upload in single merged PDF file)

* **PH-** Certificate issued by District Medical Board. Candidates with 40% and above disability are only eligible.

* **CAP** (Children of Armed Forces Personnel): Candidates whose parents are domiciled in the State of Telangana based on the permanent address/home town declared by them while joining the service and as recorded in their Service Register are alone eligible to be considered under "CAP" Category.

a) CAP Certificate (As per format attached at Appendix-A)

(i) **Retd Personnel:** CAP Certificate Issued by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer, Identity Card and Discharge Book.

(ii) **Serving Personnel:** Issued by Unit Commanding Officer (not less than the rank of Colonel/Commandant).

b) Certificate duly mentioning the permanent Home address declared at the time of Joining Armed Forces as recorded in the Service Register.

* **NCC** - Certificates issued by competent authorities.

* **Sports** – Sports Achievements / Testimonials along with the Form- I, II, III & IV duly certified / attested by the Concerned State Sports Associations recognized by the SATS which are categorized according to level of the Championships as laid down in G.O.Ms.No. 02, Youth Advancement, Tourism & Culture (Sports) Department, dated: 22-09-2020, which are essential during Scrutiny.

Note: If student wants to claim more than one category should upload the scanned documents as merged single PDF file.




Note:

- Students should submit the branch preferences in the order of their choice. Student can re-submit their preferences any no. of times before final date of submission.
- In case, student has re submitted the data of preferences, the last submitted data will be considered in allocation of branches.
- Mutual transfers in branches are not permitted after allocation.
- If the option list is incomplete or the choice is not submitted, RGUKT would allocate the branch from the left over seats.
- **The students have to compulsorily submit all the preferences in the order of 1 to 7, in order to complete the registration process.**


