

Due to pandemic COVID-19, the following evaluation pattern for declaration of PUC-II results of Semester-II of the Academic Year 2019-20 has been adopted in the video conference of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor held on 10/08/2020 with the Administrative Officer, the Associate Dean Engineering, the Associate Dean Sciences & Humanities, the Controller of Examinations (CoE) and the Additional Controller of Examinations.

1. As per the Academic Rules and Regulations of RGUKT-Basar, the Internal evaluation for PUC-II is for 40 Marks which includes Monthly tests for 30 Marks and Assignments for 10 marks. Therefore, as a onetime measure, by adopting reference 3<sup>rd</sup>, the results of the students who are eligible to appear for PUC-II, Semester-II, and who have sufficient attendance in their PUC-II, Semester-II, as per the rules, shall be declared as "pass", duly considering internal assessment marks 40 scaling to 100 marks. The Controller of Examinations is permitted to award Grades as per RGUKT academic rules and regulations.
2. Students who couldn't get pass marks by the scheme of evaluation adopted at point no.1, a pass grade (P\*) will be given in line with the procedure adopted vide reference 4<sup>th</sup>.
3. For PUC-II, Semester-II, Laboratory marks for the subjects Physics and Chemistry – the marks obtained by the student in his/her PUC-I, Semester-II marks in the respective subjects shall be considered. If any student failed or absent for PUC-I, Semester-II, Laboratory Exams, such student shall be given a P\* grade.

4. If any student does not satisfy with the grades obtained can appear for a "One-Time Special Grade Improvement Examinations" in theory (Mode of exam and pattern of exam are subject to further discussions and approval / in laboratories (laboratory exams will be held in for PUC-II labs for 100 Marks) which will be conducted by the University as and when the normalcy is restored from the COVID-19 and the University is reopened.
